

A CLUES TRAIL - CANARY WHARF

Friday 21st September 2018

A morning clues trail around Canary Wharf of just under two miles. Teams of four to five people will follow a set route, collecting the answers to a list of clues as they walk past old and new buildings, art works, street furniture and other things that catch the eye. We end in a pub at lunch time.

Entrance Fee: £5.00 per person to be paid in advance.

The Quiz: Friends can organize their own teams in advance or join a team when they arrive. Each team has a map with directions and lists of clues. There will be prizes for the highest scoring team.

There are three rounds a) written clues, b) picture clues, the answers to both these can be found on the route and c) a general knowledge round based on the route which is answered back at the pub.

Length of walk: 2 miles including some flights of steps. It should take about 1½ to 2 hours, depending on your speed and your eye sight!

Meet in the **Ledger Building pub** to the left of the Museum of London Docklands from 9.45 (if you want a tea or coffee before the start), but by 10.15 latest. You'll receive your starting instructions at 10.15 and there will be a staggered start with first teams leaving at 10.30.

If coming via Stratford, the nearest DLR station is West India Quay, otherwise get off at Westferry as other trains do not currently stop at West India Quay.
