By bus:

The 17, 45, 46, 63, 8, 25, 56, 4, 153, 242, 521, 100, 243 and 341 buses are all within walking distance of the church.

By Tube:

The following stations are within walking distance:

Barbican Station (the closest) – Circle, Hammersmith & City and Metropolitan Lines

St Paul's Station – Central Line

Farringdon Station – Circle, Hammersmith & City and Metropolitan Lines

By Car - Parking:

The nearest car parks are in West Smithfield (under the square outside the west gate to the church – access is down the ramp alongside the central park) and in Beech Street (under the Barbican)

Accessibility:

- **Step-free access:** this is available by using the path to the west door of the church from the Elizabethan Gatehouse on West Smithfield.
- You can also get to the path by coming from through the Churchyard from Cloth Fair. However, this has a significant step up into the churchyard from Cloth Fair and a further small step up beyond that within the Churchyard itself. There is then a set of relatively steep steps down onto the church path. Please note, these steps do not have a handrail. The path through the Churchyard is not suitable for anybody who would find any of these steps difficult.
