Chiswick House – Thursday, 20 April, 2023, 10:00/10:30 to late afternoon, travelling by Overground and Bus. We propose a free-of-charge visit to the gardens to see spring blooms and blossoms, with the following optional add-ons: Self-guided house and garden visit, £11 (free for English Heritage members. House visit only is also free for Art Fund card holders). Self-guided visit to kitchen garden, £4.50 (free for English Heritage members). Café and picnic area available.

London Canal Museum – Thursday 4th May (or possibly 11th May, depending on boat availability) 10:30 to early afternoon. Meet at King's Cross, Visit to Museum (£4.00) followed by canal boat trip, for those who wish to take part (additional £8). Lots to see – film, photos, info about horses/barges/goods carried etc, realia, maps and history, etc. Further options include taking a guided canal walk/exploring Coal Drops Yard and the King's Cross/St Pancras area. Coffee and various eateries locally.

Please note: Chiswick House and Gardens are open to the public Thursday-Sunday only. The Canal Museum boat trips are only available on Thursdays. Hence both of the above outings are reluctantly scheduled for a Thursday. If you would prefer to visit the canal museum only, Tuesday-Sunday please let me know your preferred days and I will consider offering a further visit.
